Actress trained at the J.C. Corazza Studio, she also studied acting in front of the camera with Iñaki Aierra, vocal technique with Concha Doñaque and Alfonso Romera, singing with Connie Philp, and flamenco dance at the Amor de Dios School.

She began her professional career with Andrés Lima forming her own company. She also worked with the Animalario Company and in the National Dramatic Center under the direction of Ernesto Caballero.

For five years she worked as a dubbing actress in Las Noticias del Guiñol of Canal +.

She has played several roles on television in series such as Hospital Central, Servir & Proteger, Heridas, and Historias para no dormir among others. In cinema, she has participated in several short films such as La Tama, nominated for a Goya Award in 2010, or in feature films such as Lope or La voz dormida.

For the last three years, she has been part of Blubalum Films, an audiovisual production company, and multipurpose space and in recent years she has developed experience as a screenwriter through short films and as a playwright.
