Born in Havana, she studied at the Film Faculty of the Instituto Superior de Arte de Cuba. She combined her career working as a director in Cuban Television and graduated in Film and TV Directing with a short film called "1993" which reflected the despair of Cubans after the fall of the Berlin Wall and won the award for Best New Director by the Union of Writers and Authors of Cuba. She emigrated to Galicia, where she has directed series broadcasted in prime time on TVG. The most outstanding series are "Dalia la modista" and "Pazo de Familia", both nominated for Best Direction by the Galician Academy of Audiovisual. Another of her series "Libro de Familia" broadcasted in the North American channel V-me, was awarded as best series by the Spanish Academy of Television. Graduated in the Master of Executive Production of Film and TV at the Escuela de Cine de Madrid (ECAM), she directs the series "Dos Vidas" broadcasted on TVE, produced by Bambú Producciones and Mascaret films. Winner of the Rose D'Or award for best daily series and nominated for the International Emmy Awards. She is currently working on the development of her first feature film "Vidas perras".
